This we pray, in Jesus' name. Amen. (A time of silent prayer)

One: People of God, receive the gift of God's Good News: God knows you even better than you know yourselves. And *still*, you are loved. No matter what you have done, or not done, you are loved. So may you live your lives differently from this day, trusting in the truth that you are loved, and you are forgiven! May you share God's blessing with all you meet, in all you do and say and think, remembering:
