One: In the stillness of this morning, we hear the Spirit singing.

All: In the stillness of this morning, the Spirit stirs our hearts with compassion.

One: In the stillness of this morning, we hear Jesus calling.

All: In the stillness of this morning, Christ calls us to pay attention to our living.

One: In the stillness of this morning, we feel God's presence here among us.

All: In the stillness of this morning, we come together to worship God.

One: Let us pray.
